

Report of First Mega Annual Camp at JIMS Hospital

The Mega health camp was inaugurated by Shri Shri Shri Tridandi Chinna Jeeyar Swamiji on 14th Feb 2014 on the occasion of the first anniversary of JIMS hospital.
